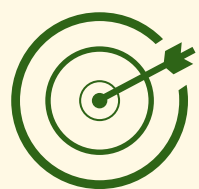

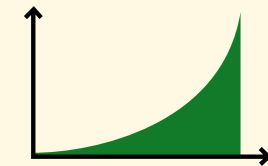
Unlike traditional volunteering, service learning is directly connected to the curriculum and emphasizes:

- Experiential learning



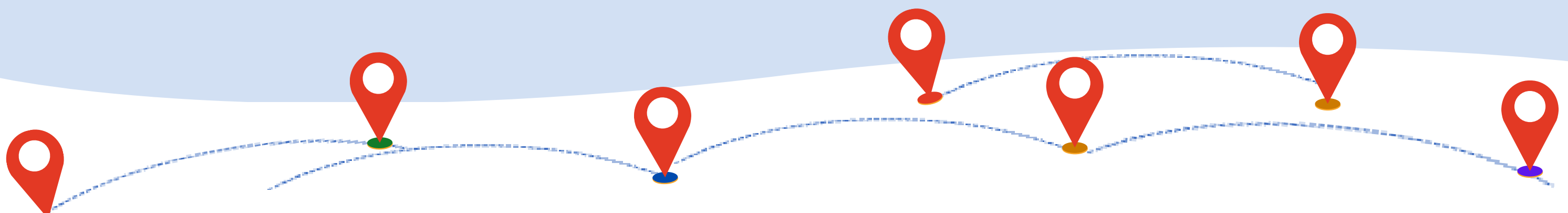
OBJECTIVES
